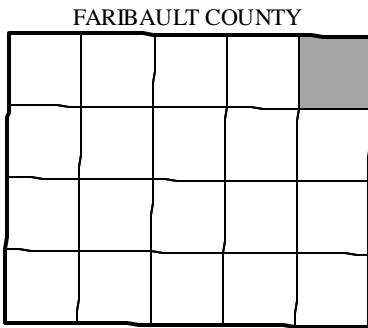

All non-conforming septic systems throughout Faribault County will be requested to upgrade their systems by the end of the year 2012. Each township is divided up uniformly and will be requested to upgrade according to the above map.

Example: All residents in Sections 4-6 throughout the county will be requested to upgrade by the end of the year 2002.

A non-conforming system COULD be:

- * Discharging sewage on the ground.
- * Discharging sewage to drain tile or surface water.
- * Sewage backed up into dwelling.
- * The potential to immediately and adversely impact or threaten public health or safety.
- * Less than 2 feet of vertical separation between system bottom and saturated soil or bedrock.
- * A seepage pit, cesspool, drywell, or leaching pit.
